

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

Purpose:

2. Exclusive Discount to ICMAI Members - ICMAI-VSH Privilege Card:

If the dispute cannot be resolved through discussions, it shall be referred to arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The arbitration shall be conducted in Bangalore, and the language of arbitration shall be English.

9. Amendments:

Any amendments to this MOU shall be made in writing and signed by both parties. No modification or waiver of any provisions of this MOU shall be valid unless in writing and signed by both parties.

10. Governing Law:

This MOU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India. The courts in Bangalore shall have exclusive jurisdiction over any matters arising out of or in connection with this MOU.

This MOU constitutes the entire agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, understandings, and representations, whether oral or written, relating to such subject matter.

14. Assignment:

Neither party may assign or transfer any rights or obligations under this MOU without the prior written consent of the other party, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld.
